• IF YOU DO NOT HAVE COVID TEST RESULTS ON COMMENCEMENT DAY: Student Health Services Nurses will be on site to coordinate an antigen test. It's important that you check-in NO LATER than 8 am so that there is enough time for the test to be taken and to get results. If the antigen test comes back positive, you will not be permitted into the stadium.
