Students complete 15 weeks of 210 hours (4 credits) or 315 hours (6 credits) of Field Education in the Fall Semester. ***Holidays or any days off from field must be made up by the student as noted on the Calendar. If the agency is closed on a day you are in field or if you have taken sick days, personal days, religious holidays, etc. the day(s) must be made up to meet the total number of hours required.***

Students must complete all Fall hours before Spring hours may begin.
